B. Review of Antitrust & Meeting Guidelines

The secretary read the ARESCA guidelines which are applicable:

The purpose of antitrust laws is to preserve economic competition in the marketplace by prohibiting, among other things, unreasonable restraints of trade. In ARESCA activities, it is important to recognize that participants often represent competitive interests. Antitrust laws require that all competition be open and unrestricted.

It is ARESCA's policy, and the policy of each of its committees and subcommittees, to conduct all business and activity openly and transparently, and in full compliance with international, federal and state antitrust and competition laws.

 - iv. Also expect that ANSI will provide useful guidance for future activities (e.g., national modifications).

- C. National Differences:
 - i. TAG meeting last week Peter Gregg provided update on inflow and loads modeling; have not found any need for national differences yet.



- ii. Small turbines list of edits from Brent and Joe is ready. Many standards refer to 61400-2, but US uses ACP 101-1. **ACTION:** George & Jonathan will ask ANSI about an easy way to address minor edits in multiple standards. Need better understanding of what can be a national difference.
- iii. **ACTION:** Kyle will circulate both summaries before next month's meeting.
- iv. Electrical issues still need a task leader. Expect to find similar issues with national differences.
- v. Site calibration Peter Gregg and John Bosche are working on a response to this issue.

 - i. Recruitment of experts no progress; Bob will try at finance conference in early March. Some possible interest from EPRI.
 - ii. George enrolled in online design course next week.
