### I. ADMINISTRATION

- A. Chair's Introductions & Announcements
  a. The participants each introduced themselves and their relevant background.
- B. Review of Antitrust & Meeting Guidelines

The secretary read the ARESCA guidelines which are applicable:

The purpose of antitrust laws is to preserve economic competition in the marketplace by prohibiting, among other things, unreasonable restraints of trade. In ARESCA activities, it is important to recognize that participants often represent competitive interests. Antitrust laws require that all competition be open and unrestricted.

It is ARESCA's policy, and the policy of each of its committees and subcommittees, to conduct all business and activity openly and transparently, and in full compliance with international, federal and state antitrust and competition laws.

C. Quorum Determination and Roster Review

The committee presently consists of 14 voting members. One more than 50% of the voting members need to be present to constitute a quorum to establish a duly constituted meeting for the purpose of conducting business.

#### II. OLD BUSINESS

- A. ANSI Audit:
  - i. Audit report received 18-Mar. Included several findings where we haven't followed our own rules, plus many commendations for existing process and suggestions for improvements.
  - ii. ANSI follow-up call scheduled for 10-May.
  - iii. Will need to revise ARESCA operating procedures.
- B. National Adoptions Subcommittee:
  - i. Publications
    - 1. 39 standards now available on ANSI webstore.
    - 2. 7 standards waiting for IEC publication; extensions granted.
  - ii. ANSI review
    - 1. Nothing at present
  - iii. Public review
    - 1. Nothing at present
- C. National Differences:
  - i. On hold pending audit report
- D. SC8A and 8B Microgrid Standards:



- i. Recruitment of experts solicited input from US TAGs but nothing received so far. George to try again. Bob will help.
- E. Offshore Safety Standards
  - i. May be some activity soon (outside of IEC) that ARESCA will want to be involved with.
  - ii. Cost of publishing no update. George and Bob to prepare an estimate.
  - iii. "Safety" may include several aspects (electrical, structural, personal).
  - iv. Alton pointed out the need to have auditable criteria in such standards.
- F. Cybersecurity standards
  - i. IEC SG11 proposed this as a "hot topic" for future standards.
  - ii. We have been asked to provide background information to support this recommendation for the SMB meeting in June.
  - iii. The dispersed assets for renewable energy generation are exceptionally vulnerable to potential cyber attacks.
  - iv. Lars may have a possible volunteer to join this effort.

- A. ARESCA was approved as TAG administrator for TC57
  - i. Will include their activities in future meetings.
